REGULATIONS:

Competition conducted as per the Queensland Chamber of Agricultural Societies Inc. general rules for Conduct of Agricultural Show Competitions.

No birds to have leg bands

All birds to be free of lice, fleas and disease

Exhibitors are NOT to talk to the Judge during judging

Birds 12 months and over to be judged as adults

Should any dispute arise for which there is no general rule applicable then the dispute will be referred to the committee and their decision will be final

Birds can only be removed from the showing area with the permission of the Chief Steward.

Any bird entered in an incorrect class may, at the discretion of the Chief Steward, be re-assigned to the correct class

Any bird found to be tampered with may, at the discretion of the Steward, Judge and/or Committee, be disqualified

The Chief Steward may combine, add or delete classes as necessary depending on entries received

The Pavilion will be open from 7:00 am to 9:00 am, Sunday 20 May, to accept exhibits

All birds must be penned by 9:00 am Sunday 20 May. NO EXCEPTIONS

Judging will commence at 10:30 am
