RULES & REGULATIONS

PLEASE BE AWARE THAT YOU SHOULD BE ABLE TO PROVE TO STEWARDS THAT ANY HORSES COMPETING AT THIS SHOW HAVE BEEN VACINATED FOR HENDRA VIRUS AND THIS IS CURRENT or a completed HORSE HEALTH DECLARATION.

Exhibitors are asked to read conditions carefully and to observe same. Please be aware that five rings will be running in unison. The stewards will do their best to ensure that the program runs as efficiently as possible whilst exhibitors compete in more than one ring. Classes will not be delayed for longer than necessary.

Nominations

- 1 Nominations for all ring events will be by ticket system. These will be available from the Ring Secretary's office from 7:30 am. Tickets must be presented to the Gate Steward before judging of a class commences. There will be no refund of entry fee if unable to compete.

Gate Charges

- 2 Gate charges do apply to competitors and/or their grooms. No exemptions, no refunds.
- 3 All entry fees shall be charged to members and non-members alike. No charge for exhibitors' trucks, cars or floats.

Marshalling

- 4 No person shall be admitted on the grounds in the vicinity of stock during the time of judging except the officials and attendants.
- 5 Every care will be taken of exhibits, but the committee will not be responsible for any losses caused by theft, fire or otherwise.
- 6 Grooms and all others in charge of exhibits must obey the orders of the Stewards or they will be fined or ejected from the grounds.
- 7 Exhibits entered in the wrong class by the exhibitor may be transferred to the proper class by the Ring Steward.
- 8 The committee reserves the right to refuse any entries they may think fit to exclude. The Ring Steward and one other committee member will ask to sight, on demand, the registrations papers of any animal, as well as any current membership.
- 9 No competitor or person is permitted to enter the ring or approach the judge without permission of the Chief Ring Steward.
- 10 The Chief Ring Steward may alter or delete classes on the program.

Stallions

- 11 All stallions over two (2) years of age must be led with a bit or chain and bar.
- 12 Colts up to two (2) years of age must be led with a chain or bit.
- 13 The Chief Ring Steward has the right to remove any stallion they consider unsafe.
- 14 Stallions cannot be ridden in Hack classes.

Ribbons & Awards

- 15 Ribbons shall be awarded to 1st, 2nd and 3rd winners in all horse sections, and to 4th place in the six bar events.
- 16 All riders to be mounted at commencement of Championship classes to be eligible to compete, unless otherwise directed by the Chief Ring Steward.
- 17 In awarding Championships, the Judge will be required to select the next animal in order of merit to be called Reserve which shall take the place of the champion in the event of the latter being disqualified for any cause the Judge deems fit.
- 18 Judges may withhold any championship honours if they think it expedient.
- 19 All ribbon winners exhibiting at the show are requested to participate in the Grand Parade if held.
- 20 Any exhibitor may not place badge or ribbon on the exhibit other than won at the Miles Show.

Protests

- 21 The decision of the Judge is final, but in the case of a dispute, a protest, in writing, by the exhibitor may be lodged with the Secretary—not later than half an hour after the decision of the judge is made known. It should be accompanied by a deposit of \$50 which will be forfeited if such protest be considered frivolous by the Committee whose decision will be final.

Ponies

- 22 All ponies heights are 14 hands (142 cm) and under, excepting Australian Saddle Ponies which are measured at 14.2 hands (147 cm) and under.
- 23 Ponies must be ridden by junior riders, 17 years and under, with the exception of stallions in ridden breed classes, and Australian Saddle Ponies.

Galloways

- 24 Galloways' heights are over 14 hands (142 cm) and not exceeding 15 hands (152 cm).

District Classes

- 25 District classes are restricted to riders resident in the former Murilla Shire, and horses owned for three (3) months prior to the Show Day by residents of the former Murilla Shire.
- 26 These classes are restricted and winners are NOT eligible for open championships.
- 27 District events are restricted to one rider per horse per event.

Maiden Classes

- 29 Open to all horses that have NOT won a first prize at a Provincial or Royal show.

Novice Classes

- 30 Open to all horses that have NOT won a Championship at a Provincial Show or a first place or Championship at a Royal Show.

Hunter Classes

- 31 Hunter classes are NOT eligible for Open Pony, Open Gallaway, Open Hack Classes or Supreme Led

Riding Attire & Headgear

- 32 Any rider under 18 years of age riding a horse at the Miles Show must wear protective headgear complying with the current Australian Standard. The retaining harness must be secured and fastened at all times.
- 33 Riders without approved headgear shall be ineligible to compete until they comply with this regulation.
- 34 Akubra style hats are acceptable wear in the Open and Performance classes by adults, at the rider's discretion.
- 35 Coats may be dispensed with in the Hack and Rider classes if the competitor wishes, and they will not be penalized for this.
- 36 Riders in district classes may compete in full pony club uniform.

Stable & Camping Bookings

- 37 Covered horse stalls MUST be booked in advance and MUST be paid for prior to the show. A fee of \$5 per stall per night applies.
- 38 Camping fees apply to all competitors camping on the grounds. A fee of \$10 per truck/van per night applies.

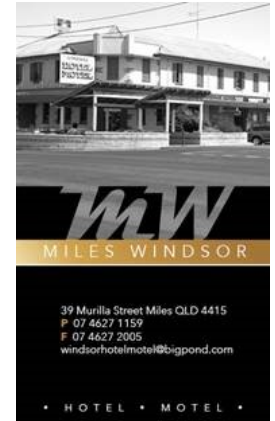
